GUIDELINES**

- Applicants must live in a household served by Ocmulgee EMC
- Recipient must be a high school senior.
- The scholarship will be paid to the university or technical college
- Funds can be used at any U.S. accredited university or technical college
- A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one student from Bleckley, Dodge, and Pulaski County
- Students must begin use of the scholarship within one year of issuance, and it must be completely used within two years of issuance
- Applications are judged based on academic ability, financial need, and community contributions
- Applications are scored anonymously by an independent (non-EMC) panel of judges
- Essay must be a 500-750 word, typed, autobiographical sketch referencing plans and goals while indicating a concern for community
